

INSTALL NOTES:

- NO DRILLING REQUIRED
- FISHWIRING REQUIRED
- TEMPORARILY LOWER EXHAUST

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Lower the exhaust by removing the two rear exhaust hangers and one in front of the axle.
- 2. After the exhaust has been lowered, fishwire a 7/16" carriage bolt and spacer through the large frame hole and out the small front hole in the frame.
- 3. Remove the fishwire from the front bolt and fishwire a carriage bolt and spacer into the rear frame hole. Repeat the process for the drivers side frame rail.
- 4. Place the U-bolt over the tow hook in the middle of the vehicle.
- 5. After all hardware has been properly installed raise the hitch into position and secure with U-bolt and flange nuts first, then attach the remaining 7/16" hardware.
- 6. Torque all 7/16" hardware to 70 ft-lbs and all 3/8" hardware to 45 ft-lbs.
- 7. Reattach the three exhaust hangers removed in Step 1.

NOTE: Modify exhaust hangers if muffler interferes with hitch.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.

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
